

CONSTITUTION ALTERATION (CANONICAL FITNESS) CANON 1989
ASSENTING ORDINANCE 1990
NO. 10 OF 1990

AN ORDINANCE

To assent to the 'Constitution Alteration (Canonical Fitness) Canon 1989' being a General Synod Canon to alter the Constitution in relation to Canonical Fitness..

PREAMBLE

Whereas it is desirable that the Constitution Alteration (Canonical Fitness) Canon 1989 of the General Synod of the Anglican Church of Australia should be assented to by the Diocese of Grafton.

Therefore the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled decree and enact as follows:-

SHORT TITLE

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the 'Constitution Alteration (Canonical Fitness) Canon 1989 Assenting Ordinance 1990.

ASSENT

- 2. The Constitution Alteration (Canonical Fitness) Canon 1989 as set out in the schedule herto is hereby assented to.

THE SCHEDULE

Canon No. 9, 1989

A Canon

to alter the Constitution in relation to Canonical Fitness

The General Synod prescribes as follows:

- 1. The Constitution is altered to the extent provided in the Schedule to this Canon.
- 2. The amendments to the Constitution made by this Canon shall come into force on a date to be appointed and declared by the Primate who shall follow, mutatis mutandis, the notification procedure prescribed by Rule XX.
- 3. This Canon may be cited as "Constitution Alteration (Canonical Fitness) Canon 1989".

Section 74(1) is amended by the substitution of the following definition for the definition of "Canonical fitness":

"Canonical fitness" means, as regards a person, that:

- (a) the person has attained at least 30 years of age;
- (b) the person has been baptised; and
- (c) the person is in priests' orders."
