

THE BUTTERY CONSTITUTION ORDINANCE 1989
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1991
No 11 of 1991.

AN ORDINANCE to amend The Buttery Constitution Ordinance 1989 in respect to the number of persons elected to the Buttery Board.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS it is desirable to vary the number of members elected to the Board at the Annual General Meeting and to vary the term for which they are elected.

AND WHEREAS by the provisions of the Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act and the Bodies Corporate (Delegation of Powers) Ordinance 1988 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during the recess of Synod to exercise certain powers and such recess now exists.

THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of Synod hereby ordains, declares, directs and rules as follows:

AMENDMENT

- 1. Clause 10.1(a) of the Second Schedule to the Buttery Constitution Ordinance 1989 is deleted and the following new clause inserted:

10.1(a) six persons elected by the subscribers at an Annual General Meeting, three for a term of one year and three for a term of two years and thereafter each year, three persons shall be elected in rotation at each Annual General Meeting for respective terms of two years.

SHORT TITLE

- 2. This Ordinance may be cited as The Buttery Board Constitution Ordinance 1989 (Amendment) Ordinance 1991.
- 3. This Ordinance shall come into effect upon receiving the assent of the Bishop.
