which they are elected.

AND WHEREAS by the provisions of the Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act and the Bodies Corporate (Delegation of Powers) Ordinance 1988 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during the recess of Synod to exercise certain powers and such recess now exists.

THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of Synod hereby ordains, declares, directs and rules as follows:

AMENDMENT

- Clause 10.1(a) of the Second Schedule to the Buttery Constitution Ordinance 1989 is deleted and the following new clause inserted:
 - six persons elected by the subscribers at an Annual General Meeting, three for a term of one year and three for a term of two years and thereafter each year, three persons shall be elected in rotation at each Annual General Meeting for respective terms of two years.

SHORT TITLE

- This Ordinance may be cited as The Buttery Board Constitution Ordinance 1989 (Amendment) Ordinance 1991.
- This Ordinance shall come into effect upon receiving the assent of the Bishop.
