

N^o 18 of 2001 **THE CATHEDRAL SCHOOL CONSTITUTION ORDINANCE 1997
AMENDING ORDINANCE 2001**

AN ORDINANCE to alter the Constitution of The Cathedral School to reduce the number of Council Members required to constitute a quorum from six (6) to five (5).

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS a Council was constituted for The Cathedral School pursuant to The Cathedral School Constitution Ordinance 1997.

AND WHEREAS the said Council was incorporated under the provisions of the Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938 pursuant to The Cathedral School Incorporation Ordinance 1997.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the number of Council members required to constitute a quorum be reduced from six (6) to five (5).

AND WHEREAS by the provisions of the said Act and the Bodies Corporate (Delegation of Powers) Ordinance 1988 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during the recess of Synod to exercise certain powers and such recess now exists;

THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod hereby ordains declares directs and rules as follows:

AMENDMENT

1. That in Clause 7.6 of the Constitution the word "six" be deleted and the word "five" be substituted therefore.

SHORT TITLE

2. This Ordinance may be cited The Cathedral School Constitution Ordinance 1997, Amending Ordinance 2001.
3. This Ordinance shall come into effect upon receiving the assent of the Bishop.
