CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT (APPELLATE TRIBUNAL PART HEARD MATTERS) CANON 2010 ASSENTING ORDINANCE 2011.

ORDINANCE NO 12 OF 2011

AN ORDINANCE

To assent to the "Constitution Amendment (Appellate Tribunal Part Heard Matters) Canon 2010" being a General Synod Canon.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Constitution Amendment (Appellate Tribunal Part Heard Matters) Canon 2010 of the General Synod of the Anglican Church of Australia should be assented to by the Diocese of Grafton.

THEREFORE the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled decree and enact as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Constitution Amendment (Appellate Tribunal Part Heard Matters) Canon 2010 Assenting Ordinance 2011.

ADOPTION

2. The constitution Amendment (Appellate Tribunal Part Heard Matters) Canon 2010 as set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby assented to.

DATE OF COMMENCEMENT

3. This Ordinance shall come into effect on the date that the Bishop assents to this Ordinance.

CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT (APPELLATE TRIBUNAL PART HEARD MATTERS) CANON 2010

The General Synod prescribes as follows:

Title

1. This Canon may be cited as the "Constitution Amendment (Appellate Tribunal Part Heard Matters) Canon 2010".

Amendment of Section 57 of the Constitution

- 2. Insert after Section 57(1) of the Constitution:
 - (1A) Despite the restrictions in Section 57(1) on the composition of the Appellate Tribunal, the General Synod may by canon provide for
 - (a) the continuation in office of a member of the tribunal whose office is to be vacated, but who is participating in the disposition of an appeal, question or matter made or referred to the tribunal that will not be concluded by the date on which the member's office is to be vacated, for the purposes only of participating in and concluding that unfinished appeal, question or matter; and
 - (b) the appointment of a person to fill the office of such member –

and the person so appointed must not participate in that unfinished appeal, question or matter, but is the member of the tribunal for all other appeals, questions or matters.
