

**The Buttery Constitution Ordinance 1989  
(Amendment) Ordinance 1995**

**No of 1995**

**AN ORDINANCE** to amend The Buttery Constitution Ordinance 1989 in respect to procedures for the Winding up of The Buttery and to establish a mechanism for resolving internal disputes.

**PREAMBLE**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Clause 25.3 of the Second Schedule to The Buttery Constitution Ordinance 1989 the Board of Management of The Buttery has requested Bishop-in-Council to make certain amendments to the Constitution.

**AND WHEREAS** it is desirable to vary the procedures for the Winding up of The Buttery and to establish a mechanism for resolving internal disputes.

**AND WHEREAS** by the provisions of the Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act and the Bodies Corporate (Delegation of Powers) Ordinance 1988 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during the recess of Synod to exercise certain powers and such recess now exists.

**THEREFORE** the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod hereby ordains declares directs and rules as follows:

**AMENDMENT**

- 1. Clause 26.2 of the Second Schedule is amended by deleting the words "registered or exempt Charity" and inserting in place thereof the words "non-profit organisation with similar objects to The Buttery."
- 2. That the following Clauses be added to the Second Schedule:
  - 27. INTERNAL DISPUTES**
  - 27.1 The Buttery Board of Management shall ensure that a mechanism is established for resolving internal disputes within its membership. This may include:
    - (a) the appointment of an independent person to arbitrate in the dispute.
    - (b) a process to bring the parties together to resolve the dispute at an early stage;
    - (c) a process to ensure that all parties receive a full and fair opportunity of presenting their case;
    - (d) where the dispute cannot be resolved internally by arbitration or mediation, to refer the matter to a Community Justice Centre which functions as a centre for dispute settlement.
  - 28. COMPLAINTS**
  - 28.1. The Buttery Board of Management shall ensure that a mechanism is established that will properly and effectively deal with complaints made by members of the public and grievances from employees.

**SHORT TITLE**

- 3. This Ordinance may be cited as The Buttery Board Constitution Ordinance 1989 (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995.
- 4. This Ordinance shall come into effect upon receiving the assent of the Bishop.
