THE ORARA VALLEY RECTORY LEASING ORDINANCE 2006

No. 2

AN Ordinance to provide for the leasing by the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton of the Rectory located at 12 Orara Street, Nana Glen in the Parochial District of the Orara Valley

PREAMBLE

<u>WHEREAS</u> the lands described in the Schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton <u>AND WHEREAS</u> by the *Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act of 1917* and the *Church Trust Property Ordinance 1934* – 2005 Bishop-in-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of Synod including the powers conferred by Part VI of the said Act <u>AND WHEREAS</u> such recess now exists Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

AUTHORITY TO LEASE

- The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to lease the Rectory situated at 12 Orara Street, Nana Glen, for such term and at such rent and subject to such exceptions reservations powers conditions covenants agreements provisoes as may be approved by the Parochial Council and the Diocesan Property Board.
- 2. The Corporate Trustees are hereby authorised to execute, or authorise the execution of leases and other instruments acts measures and things necessary for giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance according to its true intent and meaning.

SHORT TITLE

This Ordinance may be cited as The Orara Valley Rectory Leasing Ordinance 2006.
