# THE PARISH OF GRAFTON 36 VICTORIA STREET SALE ORDINANCE 2010 (NO 7 OF 2010)

An Ordinance to provide for the sale of certain lands at 36 Victoria Street, Grafton in the Diocese of Grafton.

#### **PREAMBLE**

<u>WHEREAS</u> the lands described in the Schedule hereto are vested in The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton.

**THEREFORE** The Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton decree and enact as follows:

#### **OPINION**

1. It has become and is expedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of any trusts relating to the lands described in the schedule hereto, to sell the same.

### **POWERS TO SELL**

- 2. The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the same by public auction or private contract for such sum or sums of money and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton.
- The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton are hereby authorised to execute and do all necessary
  deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things for giving full and complete
  effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
- 4. The money arising out of such sale shall be paid to The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton and, after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating thereto, the net proceeds shall be held in trust by The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton to be used for the repayment of the Diocesan debt.

#### **SHORT TITLE**

This Ordinance may be cited as the Parish of Grafton 36 Victoria Street Land Sale Ordinance 2010.
