THE BRUNSWICK HEADS BUILDING FUND (VARIATION OF TRUST) ORDINANCE 1989.

URDINANCE NO 7 OF 1987

An Ordinance to provide for the variation of trust of certain funds held by the Corporate Trustees for St.Thomas' Church, Brunswick Heads in the Parish of Mullumbimby.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the funds described in the Schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance 1934 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of Synod including the powers conferred by part VI of the said Act AND WHEREAS such recess now exists the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

OPINION

- 1. It has become and is expedient by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the said Trust to vary the purpose for which the Trust was originally created, as the original funds have been expended and the funds now held do not fall within the terms of the Trust.
- 2. In lieu of the said trust it is hereby declared that the funds held, as set out in the schedule together with the interest further accrued since that date less any payments made in accordance with the original trusts, shall henceforth be held by the Corporate Trustees in trust for the following purposes and terms as unanimously carried by the meeting of the Mullumbimby Parochial Council held on 9th October, 1988, and be used for the purpose of development in the Parish.

SHORT TITLE

 This Ordinance may be cited as the Brunswick Heads Building Fund (Variation of Trust) Ordinance 1989.
