

THE SYNOD ORDINANCE 1972 AMENDING ORDINANCE 1991.

No. 8 of 1991.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Synod Ordinance 1972 to:

1. Provide for the ex-officio membership of Synod by The Diocesan Advocate and
2. Provide a procedure for dealing with motions for which less than 21 days notice has been given.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS it is desirable that the Diocesan Advocate be granted ex-officio membership of the Synod of the Diocese: and that there be a procedure for dealing with motions to come before a Session of Synod and for which less than 21 days notice has been given:

THEREFORE the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled decree and enact as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. (a) This Ordinance may be cited as The Synod Ordinance 1972 Amending Ordinance 1991.
1. (b) The Synod Ordinance 1972 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

AMENDMENTS

2. Section 3(c) of the Principal Ordinance is deleted and the following substituted:
 3. (c) The Chancellor, The Registrar, The Diocesan Advocate and the Treasurer of the Diocese.
3. Section 15 (2) of The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is deleted and the following substituted:
 - 15 (2) Motions for which less than 21 days notice before the first sitting day of a session has been given shall not be included on the agenda unless:
 - (a) Upon notices of motion being called for by the President the mover reads the proposed motion and gives reasons why the motion should be placed on the agenda: and
 - (b) Synod on motion without notice immediately resolves that such proposed motion should be placed on the agenda.

DATE OF COMMENCEMENT

- 4. This Ordinance shall come into effect upon receiving the assent of the Bishop.
