

## Eureka Land Vesting Ordinance, 1946

WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917, it is declared that any Church Trust Property which may at any time belong to or be vested in any Trustee or Trustees shall upon the consent of such Trustee or Trustees given in writing by virtue of such consent and without other assurance in law become vested in the Corporate Trustees of such Diocese AND WHEREAS all that piece or parcel of land situated in the Parish of Clunes and County of Ross containing two roods five perches being the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title dated Twenty-ninth day of December One thousand nine hundred registered Volume 1341 Folio 49 was formerly vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton and Armidale and was held by them as Church Trust Property for the purposes of the Church of England AND WHEREAS by the Grafton Diocese Ordinance 1910 passed by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton and Armidale in that year it was enacted that from and after the confirmation and election of a duly qualified person in Episcopal Orders to be Bishop of Grafton all that portion of the State of New South Wales defined and described in the schedule to the deed poll or instrument recited in the Grafton Vicarage Land Vesting Ordinance 1923 published in the Government Gazette of the Seventh day of December One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three should become and be a separate Diocese to be called the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS the limits of the said Diocese of Grafton are set out and recited in the aforesaid Grafton Vicarage Land Vesting Ordinance and the aforesaid land is situated within those limits and it is desirable that the said land should be vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton, NOW THEREFORE the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled in exercise of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and all other powers thereunto enabling it ordains, declares, determines and rules as follows:—

1. Consent is hereby given to the land before described being by virtue of such consent and without further assurance in law vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Eureka Land Vesting Ordinance, 1946."
