To amend the Cathedral Ordinance 1937 - 1949 by increasing the right of appointment of Honorary Canons thereunder.

WHEREAS by Section 10 subsection (h) of an Ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton passed in the year One thousand nine hundred and thirty four and known as the Bishop-in-Council Ordinance 1934 the Sishop-in-Council was thereby empowered to discharge all duties specifically assigned to it from time to time by the Synod of the Diocese under resolution consistently with the constitution of the Church and the Ordinances of Symod AM) WEEREAS by a resolution duly submitted to and carried at a session of the said Synod upon the handling day of Salling One thousand nine hundred and fifty one the Bishop-in-Council was thereby directed to take such steps as would enable the Bishop to confer the title of Canon Emeritus upon Archieacon Burvill on his retirement NCW THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers and duties in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Ordinance and resolution and in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Synod by the constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales or otherwise in the name and in the place of such Synod ordains (directs and rules as follows: -

- 1. The following Section shall be inserted and read immediately following Section 13 of the Cathedral Ordinance 1937-1949 namely:
 - 13 A In addition to the appointments as hereinbefore provided the Bishop shall have and may exercise the right to confer the title Canon Emeritus upon the Venerable Archdeacon W. Furvill upon his retirement.
