UKI LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1974

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the sale of certain lands at Uki in the Parish of Murwillumbah.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the lands described in the Schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton
of England Trust Property Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property
Ordinance 1934 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of Synod including the powers conferred by Part
VI of the said Act AND WHEREAS such recess now exists the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

OPINION

 It has become and is expedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts relating to the lands described in the schedule hereto to sell the same.

POWERS TO SELL

- 2. The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the same by public auction or private contract and for such sum or sums of money and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Corporate Trustees.
- 3. The Corporate Trustees are hereby authorised to execute and do all necessary deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things for giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
- 4. The moneys arising out of such sale shall be paid to the Corporate Trustees and after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating thereto shall be applied by them to such purposes as the Parochial Council of Murwillumbah may nominate subject to the approval of the Bishop-in-Council.

SHORT TITLE

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Uki Land Sale Ordinance 1974.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land being portion 115 containing 1 rood 39 perches and part of portion 116 containing 1 rood 19½ perches situated in the village of Uki Shire of Tweed Parish of Nullum and County of Rous and being the whole of the land in Certificate of Title Volume 3410 Folio 209.
