PORT HACOUARTE GLERE GREENDEENT) ORDINANCE 1977

ORDINANCE

To further amend the Port Macquarie Glebe Ordinance 1948 - 1950.

The Bishop, the Clergy and the Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled declare ordain and enact as follows:-

SHORT TITLE

- 1(a) This ordinance may be cited as the "Port Macquarie Glebe (Amendment) Ordinance 1977.
- (b) The Port Macquarie Glebe Ordinance 1946 1950 is in this Ordinance referred to as the "Principal Ordinance".
- (c) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the "Port Macquarie Glebe Ordinance 1948 1977".

AMENDMENT

- 2. The following section shall be inserted and read immediately following Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance:-
 - "3A. Notwithstanding enything contained in this Ordinance or in any amendment hereof the following shall apply to the lots in the third Glebe subdivision which is a subdivision of Lot 10 in Deposited Plan No. 243242 into Lots 9 to 25 inclusive in Deposited Plan No. 249270:-
 - (a) Lot 21 D.P. 249270 shall be reserved from sale and retained by the trustees for the purpose of erecting thereon a second Curatage for the Parish of Port Macquarie;
 - (b) The three fifths share from the nett proceeds of sale of the lots in D.P. 249270 (other than Lot 21) to which the Parish of Port Macquarie is entitled pursuant to Section 2 of the Port Macquarie Glebe (Amendment) Ordinance 1950 shall be paid or credited to the Port Macquarie New Church Suilding Fund."
