# BAGNOO LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1972

 ${\tt N}$  ORDINANČE to provide for the sale of certain lands at Eagnoo in the Parish of lpper Hastings.

## PREAMBLE

HEREAS the lands described in the Schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate rustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust roperty Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance 1934 the Bishop-n-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of ynod including the powers conferred by Part VI of the said Act AND WHEREAS 1ch recess now exists the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

#### OPINION

It has become and is expedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to secretary to sell the same.

## POWERS TO SELL

The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby emwered and directed to sell the same by public auction or private contract and r such sum or sums of money and upon such terms and conditions as may be dermined by the Corporate Trustees.

The Corporate Trustees are hereby authorised to execute and do all necesry deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things r giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.

The moneys arising out of such sale shall be paid to the Corporate Trustees i after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating preto shall be applied by them to such purposes as the Parochial Council of per Hastings may nominate subject to the approval of Bishop-in-Council.

## SHORT TITLE

This Ordinance may be cited as the Bagnoo Land Sale Ordinance 1972.
