

Diocesan Education Ordinance, 1933. Amending Ordinance, 1943.

PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Diocesan Education Ordinance 1933 in respect of the elective members of the Diocesan Board of Education be it therefore ordained by the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled as follows:—

AMENDMENT.

1. Section 2 of the Diocesan Education Ordinance 1933 is hereby amended by the addition of the following words after the word "Synod" where first used in the said Section that is to say:—

"Provided always that on nomination by a resolution of the Board the Bishop in Council may at any time elect an additional member or additional members either men or women, but not exceeding three in number."

2. Section 3 of the said Ordinance is amended by the addition of the words "and additional members shall hold office for the unexpired part of the same period."

SHORT TITLE.

3. This Ordinance shall be known and cited as "The Diocesan Education Ordinance 1933 Amendment Ordinance 1943," and shall come into effect upon the assent of the Bishop.
