## MURWILLUMBAH BUILDING ORDINANCE 1951.

WHEREAS a certain fund known as "Murwillumbah Church Building Fund" was collected subscribed and raised for the purpose of building a new Church within the Parish of Murwillumbah and, if considered expedient, incorporating a Parish Hall in the foundations of the new Church building and which was pursuant to and by virtue of Section 1 of the Parochial Building Funds Temporary Vesting and Management Ordinance 1931 and Section 113 of the Parochial Ordinance 1936, deposited with and vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances to which attention has been drawn by the Parochial Council and Parishioners of the said Parish, it has become inexpedient to carry out the said trusts and it is expedient to declare that in lieu thereof the said Fund should be held in trust and utilised for the construction of a new Parish Hall within the said Parish AND WHEREAS by Section 32 of the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 it was made lawful for the Synod of the said Diocese to declare such their opinion and by the same or any subsequent ordinance\_to declare other trusts for or for the use benefit or purposes of the Church within the said Diocese instead of such first mentioned trusts and such first mentioned trusts should thereupon by force of the said Ordinance cease and determine and the said Fund should thereupon be held upon such other trusts accordingly AND WHEREAS by Section 40 of the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 it was enacted that during the recess of the Synod of a Diocese such committee council or other body of persons as should be constituted for the purpose by ordinance of such Synod might exercise such of the powers and functions and do and make such of the things referred to in that act as such Synod should from time to time by Ordinance direct AND WHEREAS by Section 42 of the Church Trust Property Ordinance 1934 the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton appointed the Bishop-in-Council of the said Diocese to

exercise within the said Diocese and during recess of the said Synod certain powers given to the said Synod by the said Act including the powers conferred by Section 32 thereof AND WHEREAS the said Synod is now in recess NOW the Bishop-in-Council of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by Section 32 of the said Act and by the said Ordinance and of all other powers thereunto in anywise enabling hereby ordains directs and rules:

## OPINION.

1. It has become and is inexpedient to carry out the particular trusts upon which the Fund known as "Murwillumbah Church Building Fund" is held.

## CHANGE OF TRUST.

2. In lieu of such first mentioned trusts it is hereby declared that the said Fund shall henceforth be held upon trust and
utilised for the construction of a new Parish Hall within the said
Parish and the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton are
hereby authorised and empowered accordingly.

## SHORT TITLE.

3. This Ordinance may be cited and known as the Murwillumbah Building Ordinance 1951.
