The Diocesan Progress Fund (Amendment) Ordinance 1955

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Diocesan Progress Fund Ordinance 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Ordinance").

WHEREAS the office of Diocesan Commissioner is now vacant AND WHEREAS by Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance any such vacancy may be filled by the Bishop-in-Council NOW THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers and duties conferred upon it by the said Ordinance and of the powers vested in the said Synod by the constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales or otherwise in the name and in the place of such Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

APPOINTMENT

1. Mr. Walter Launcelet Meek is hereby appointed Diocesan Commissioner for a term of two years as from the 15th day of May, 1955, and the action of the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton in making such provisional appointment is hereby adopted and confirmed.
2. The said appointment shall be otherwise upon the same terms and conditions as are provided for in and by the principal Ordinance.

SHORT TITLE

3. This Ordinance may be cited and known as the Diocesan Progress Fund (Amendment) Ordinance 1955. I certify that this Ordinance was passed by the Bishop-in-Council on the 22nd June, 1955.

Murwillumbah Land Mortgage (Amendment) Ordinance 1955

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Murwillumbah Land Mortgage Ordinance 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principle Ordinance") by increasing the borrowing powers of the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton thereunder.

The Administrator, the Clergy and the Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled declare ordain and enact as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Murwillumbah Land Mortgage (Amendment) Ordinance 1955.

AMENDMENT

2. Section 1 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words and figures "Six thousand eight hundred pounds (£6800/0/0)" for the words and figures "Three thousand pounds (£3000/0/0)" where therein appearing.

3. Section 2 of the said Ordinance is hereby amended by interposing the words "and augmenting the funds of the Parish of Murwillumbah by the implementation of the Wells Organisation Scheme" between the words "thereto" and "as" where occurring in the fifth line thereof.
