GRAFTON BISHOPRIC AND ADMINISTRATION (AMENDING) ORDINANCE 1972

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Grafton Bishopric and Administration Ordinance 1936-1961 by fixing a maximum age at retirement of the Bishop of Grafton.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the licence of any incumbent to a Cure-of-Souls in the Diocese of Grafton must terminate not later than his seventieth birthday AND WHEREAS it is desirable that a similar limitation apply to the tenure of the See of Grafton by any Bishop of Grafton NOW THEREFORE the Bishop Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled declare ordain and rule as follows:-

SHORT TITLE

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Grafton Bishopric and Administration (Amending) Ordinance 1972.

AMENDMENT

2. Section 4 of the Grafton Bishopric and Administration Ordinance 1936-1961 is amended by adding at the end thereof the following:-


"and such resignation must be made so as to be effective from a date not later than the seventieth birthday of that Bishop of Grafton."


