— THE CLERGY PROVIDENT FUND (AMENDMENT) —

ORDINANCE 1950.

— AN ORDINANCE —

To further amend the Diocesan Funds (Consolidated) Ordinance 1931 in connection with the Clergy Provident Fund WHEREAS it has become expedient to vary certain provisions in and about the carrying out of the Trusts prescribed by and under the Principal Ordinance AND WHEREAS by Act of Parliament passed in the eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George the Fifth entitled "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" it was enacted that during the recess of the Synod, a Committee, Council or other body of persons appointed for that purpose by Ordinance might, in place of the Synod of the Diocese exercise such of the powers and functions and do and make such of the things referred to in the said Act as should be determined by Ordinance of the Synod of such Diocese AND WHEREAS by ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton passed in the year One thousand nine hundred and thirty four the Bishop-in-Council was appointed for the purpose of exercising and might accordingly, during the recess of such Synod of the said Diocese, exercise in the place of such Synod any or all of the powers and functions and do and make any or all of the things referred to in Section 32 of the said Act as may be done by the Synod NOW THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Act and Ordinance and in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Synod by the Constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and

by the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" or otherwise in the name and in the place of such Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:-----

SHORT TITLE.

1. (a) This Ordinance may be cited as the Clergy Provident Fund (Amendment) Ordinance 1950. -----

(b) The Diocesan Funds (Consolidated) Ordinance 1931 as previously amended is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. -----

(c) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as "The Diocesan Funds (Consolidated) Ordinance 1931-1950. -----

OPINION.

1. It has become and is inexpedient to carry out certain of the trusts upon which the respective funds are administered by the Corporate Trustees and it is expedient to vary the same.

AMENDMENT.


2. Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "operating on the mutual principal and".


