

THE GRAFTON BISHOPRIC ENDOWMENT AND ADMINISTRATION
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1954.

AN ORDINANCE.

To further amend the Grafton Bishopric Endowment Ordinance 1933 and the Grafton Bishopric and Administration Ordinance 1936 WHEREAS by Section 18 sub-section (h) of an Ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton passed in the year One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four and known as the Bishop-in-Council Ordinance 1934, the Bishop-in-Council was thereby empowered to discharge all duties specifically assigned to it from time to time by the Synod of the Diocese under resolution consistently with the constitution of the Church and the Ordinances of Synod AND WHEREAS by a resolution duly submitted to and carried at a session of the said Synod upon the twenty ninth day of September 1953 the Bishop-in-Council was thereby directed to amend the existing Ordinances in terms of this enactment NOW THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers and duties in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Bishop-in-Council Ordinance and resolution and in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Synod by the constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales or otherwise in the name and in the place of such Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

SHORT TITLE.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Grafton Bishopric Endowment and Administration (Amendment) Ordinance 1954"

AMENDMENT.

2. Sections 4 and 5 of the Grafton Bishopric Endowment Ordinance 1933 are amended by substituting the words "One thousand two hundred and fifty pounds together with such provision for the Bishop's travel and house allowances as the Synod may from year to year deem adequate" for the words "One thousand pounds" wherever there in appearing.
3. Section 15 of the Grafton Bishopric and Administration Ordinance 1936 is amended by substituting the words "One thousand two hundred and fifty pounds together with such provision for the Bishop's travel and house allowances as the Synod may from year to year deem adequate" for the words "One thousand pounds"
4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force and become fully effective as from the first day of July, 1953.
