PALMERS ISLAND LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1964

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the sale of certain lands at Palmers Island in the Parish of Maclean.

PREAMBLE

NHEREAS the lands described in the schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND NHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance of 1934 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of Synod including the powers conferred by Part VI of the said Act AND NHEREAS such recess now exists the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:-

<u>OPINION</u>

1. It has become and is expedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts relating to the lands described in the schedule hereto, to sell the same.

POWER TO SELL

- 2. The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the same by public auction or private contract and for such sum or sums of money and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Corporate Trustees.
- 3. The Corporate Trustees are hereby authorised to execute and do all necessary deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things for giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
- 4. The moneys arising out of such sale shall be paid to the Corporate Trustees and after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating thereto shall be applied by them to such purposes as the Parochial Council of Maclean may desire or in such manner and towards such other purpose as the Bishop-in-Council shall direct.

SHORT TITLE

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Palmers Island Land Sale Ordinance 1964.

ALL THAT piece of land being Lots 1 and 2, Section 4, situated at Palmersville in the Parish of Taloumbi and County of Clarence, Volume 1407, Folio 234, Deposited plan No 2107 containing thirty two perches.
