LISMORE LAND SALE ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the sale of certain Lands at Lismore in the Parish of Lismore.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the lands described in the Schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance 1934 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of Synod including the powers conferred by Part VI of the said Act AND WHEREAS such recess now exists the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

 $\sqrt{1}$. It has become and is expedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts relating to the lands described in the schedule hereto to sell the same.

POWERS TO SELL

- The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the same by public auction or private contract and for such sum or sums of money and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Corporate Trustees.
- The Corporate Trustees are hereby authorised to execute and do all necessary deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things for giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
- The moneys arising out of such sale shall be paid to the Corporate Trustees and after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating thereto shall be applied by them to such purposes as the Parochial Council of Lismore may nominate subject to the approval of the Bishop-in-Council.

SHORT TITLE

This Ordinance may be cited as the Lismore Land Sale Ordinance 1974.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT piece of land situate at North Lismore in the Municipality of Lismore Parish of North Lismore County of Rous having a frontage of about 50 feet to Pine Street by a depth of about 98 feet and containing 26 perches or thereabouts being Lot 3 in a subdivision of part portion 19 sold by John Peate to one James Mitchell Lot 3 in a subdivision of part portion 19 sold by John Peate to one James Mitchell in the said Parish and being the whole of the land comprised in Conveyance Registing 18 200 Peat 2003 ered No. 390 Book 2211.
