

The Port Macquarie Rectory Land Mortgage Ordinance, 1936.

PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS the lands described in the Schedule hereto and known as the Port Macquarie Rectory Lands are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton. AND Whereas funds are required in order to restore and remodel the Rectory House erected thereon. And Whereas a petition has been made in due form to the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton under the provisions of the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917, to mortgage the said lands for a sum not exceeding seven hundred and fifty pounds. And Whereas it is expedient to give effect to the said application. Now the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 (No. 21) and of all other powers thereunto enabling it ordains declares determines directs and rules as follows:—

DECLARATION OF OPINION.

1. It is expedient and desirable to mortgage the lands described in the Schedule hereto for a sum not exceeding seven hundred and fifty pounds for the purpose of raising moneys to defray the cost of restoring and remodelling the Rectory house erected thereon.
