EATONSVILLE LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1967

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the sale of certain land at Eatonsville in the Parochial Bistrict of Copmanhurst.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the land described in the schedule hereto is vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance of 1934 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of Synod including the powers conferred by Part VI of the said Act AND WHEREAS such recess now exists the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

OPINION

 It has become and is expedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts relating to the land described in the schedule hereto, to sell the same.

POWERS TO SELL

- 2. The Corporate Trustees in whom the said land is vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the same by public auction or private contract and for such sum or sums of money and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Corporate Trustees.
- 3. The Corporate Trustees are hereby authorised to execute and do all necessary deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things for giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
- 4. The moneys arising out of such sale shall be paid to the Corporate Trustees and after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating thereto shall be applied by them to such purposes as the Parochial Council of Copmanhurst may nominate subject to the approval of the Bishop-in-Council.

SHORT TITLE

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Eatonsville Land Sale Ordinance, 1967.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT Piece or Parcel of Land in Our said State containing by Admeasurement one rood thirty eight perches be the same more or less situated in the County of Clarence and Parish of Rushforth. Being Portions 213 and 214 of Land Grant Volume 4008 Folio 96.
