BALLINA LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1978

An Ordinance to provide for the sale of certain lands at West Ballina in the Parish of Ballina.

Preamble

WHEREAS the lands described in the Schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance 1934 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of Synod including the powers conferred by Part V1 of the said Act AND WHEREAS such recess now exists the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

Opinion

1. It has become and is expedient, by reason of circulstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts relating to the lands described in the schedule hereto to sell the same.

Powers to Sell

- 2. The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the same by public auction or private contract and for such sum or sums of money and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Corporate Trustees.
- 3. The Corporate Trustees are hereby authorised to execute and do all necessary deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things for giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
- 4. The moneys arising out of such sale shall be paid to the Corporate Trustees and after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating thereto shall be held in trust for the provision of a permanent woman in the name of "The Edith Bryden Hemorial" in the Parish of Ballina.

Short Title

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Ballina Land Sale Ordinance 1978.

Schedule |

ALL THAT piece of land containing eighteen perches or thereabouts situate at West Ballina in the Parish of Ballina County of Rous being Lot 5 Deposited Plan No. 21459 and being the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title Volume 6068 Folio 60.
