THE DIOCESAN DEVELOPMENT FUND (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1954 AN ORDINANCE.

To amend the Diocesan Development Fund Ordinance 1949-1950 WHEREAS it has become necessary and desirable to borrow certain additional moneys towards the completion of a building at Grafton for a dommunity Centre for youth gatherings, conferences and retreats and provision of the furnishings and equipment therein AND WHEREAS by Act of Parliament passed in the eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George the Fifth entitled *Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 No. 21 " it was enacted that during the recess of the Synod, a Committee, Council or other body of persons appointed for that purpose by Ordinance might, in place of the Synod of the Diocese exercise such of the powers and functions and do and make such of the things referred to in the said Act as should be determined by Ordinance of the Synod of such Diocese AND WHEREAS by Ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton passed in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four the Bishop-in-Council was appointed for the purpose of exercising and might accordingly during the recess of such Synod of the said Diocese exercise in the place of such Synod any or all of the powers and functions and do and make any or all of the things referred to in Sections 26, 27 and 32 of the said Act as may be done by the Synod AND WHERE AS by the said Diocesan Development Fund Ordinance 1949-1950 the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton (hereinafter called "the Corporate Trustees") were thereby authorised for such purposes to berrow such additional moneys as the Bishop-in-Council might deem necessary or desirable NOW THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Synod the said Act and the said Ordinances and in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Synod by the Constitution 1 the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" or otherwise in the name and the plof such Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:-

SHORT TITLE

- 1.(a) This Ordinance may be cited as the Diocesan Develop.
 Fund (Amendment) Ordinance 1954.
- (b) The Diocesan Development Fund Ordinance 1949-1950 a amended by this Ordinance may be cited as "Diocesan Develop Fund Ordinance 1949-1954."

OPINION

1. It has become necessary and desirable for the purpo aforesaid to borrow certain additional moneys.

AMENDMENT -

2. Pursuant to and in virtue of the powers and authori conferred by Section 3 of the Diocesan Development Fund (Asment) Ordinance 1950, the Corporate Trustees are hereby auted and empowered to borrow the sum of Twelve thousand pound (£12000.0.0) towards the completion of the said building as provision of the furnishings and equipment therein.
