

✓ STANDING ORDERS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE ~~1961~~ 1938 (Amendment) Ordinance  
1961.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND the Standing Orders Ordinance 1938 (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Ordinance") to provide for the appointment of a Clerk of Committees and to vary the introduction of Ordinances to Synod.

NOW THEREFORE the Bishop the Clergy and the Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled declare ordain and enact as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Standing Orders (Amendment) Ordinance 1961.

AMENDMENT

2. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance shall be amended by inserting the words "and a Clerk of Committees" after the words "Lay Secretary".
3. Section 63(a) of the principal ordinance shall be amended.

After the words "Every ordinance" insert the words "to which Order 62 does not apply" and after the word "and" where first occurring delete the words "except when introduced by request of the Bishop-in-Council."
