

ALSTONVILLE LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1966

AN ORDINANCE

to provide for the sale of certain lands at Dalwood in the Parish of Alstonville.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the lands described in the schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance of 1934 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of Synod including the powers conferred by Part VI of the said Act AND WHEREAS such recess now exists the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

OPINION

1. It has become and is expedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts relating to the lands described in the schedule hereto, to sell the same.

POWERS TO SELL

2. The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested and hereby empowered and directed to sell the same by public auction or private contract and for such sum or sums of money and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Corporate Trustees.
3. The Corporate Trustees are hereby authorised to execute and do all necessary deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things for giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
4. The monies arising out of such sale shall be paid to the Corporate Trustees and after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating thereto shall be applied ~~by them~~ for the purpose of renovations to the Rectory at Alstonville. *detiba*

SHORT TITLE

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alstonville Land Sale Ordinance 1966.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT piece of land situated in the County of Rous Parish of Meerschaum being Portion 89 containing two roods Volume 725, Folio 14 and ALL THAT piece of land situated in the County of Rous Parish of Meerschaum being Portion 88 containing one acre Volume 725 Folio 13.
