

FRED HALL MEMORIAL TRUST ORDINANCE 1982

An Ordinance to Vary the Trusts Relating to "FRED HALL MEMORIAL TRUST".

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS FREDERICK JAMES HALL late of Grafton Retired Mercer by his last Will and Testament gave devised and bequeathed the residue of his estate to the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton to establish a fund to be known as the "Fred Hall Memorial Trust" (hereinafter called the said Fund) to be held by the Trustees upon the trusts set out in the said Will (hereinafter called the said Trusts) AND WHEREAS the said Fund now vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton consists of the assets set out in the Schedule hereto AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the said Trusts it has become expedient to carry out the said Trusts AND WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance 1934 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of Synod including the powers conferred by Section 32 of the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 AND WHEREAS such recess now exists NOW THEREFOR the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:-

OPINION

1. It has become and is inexpedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the said Trusts, to carry out the same.

CHANGE OF TRUST

2. In lieu of the said trusts it is hereby declared that the assets in the said Fund shall henceforth be held by the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton to be paid by it, into the fund known as "THE CATHEDRAL RESTORATION FUND".


SHORT TITLE

This Ordinance may be cited as the "Fred Hall Memorial Trust Ordinance 1982."


SCHEDULE
