DIOCESE OF GRAFTON.

THE LISMORE LAND FORTGAGE ORBINANCE 1934 AMENDING ORDINANCE 1939.

WHEREAS it is expedient to continue and to supplement the powers conferred by the Lismore land mortgage ordinance 1934 and for that purpose to amend the said crainance AND WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament passed in the eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George the fifth intituled "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" it was enacted that during the recess of the Synod, a Committee, Gouncil, or other body of persons appointed for that purpose by Ordinance might, in the place of such Synod of the Diocese exercise such of the powers and functions and do and make such of the things referred to in the said Act as should be determined by Ordinance of the Synod of such Diocese and whereas by an Ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton passed in the year 1934 the Bishop-in-Gouncil was appointed for the purpose of exercising and might accordingly during the recess of such Synod of the said Diocese exercise in the place of such Synod any or all of the powers and the functions and do and make any or all of the things referred to in such Act, Section 26 thereof, as may be done by the Synod. NOW the Bishop-in-Council of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conforred upon it by the said Act and Ordinance and in pursuances of the powers vested in the said Synod by the Constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the "Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917", or otherwise in the name and in the place of such Synod ordeins, directs and rules as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Lismore Land Mortgage Ordinance 1934 Amending Ordinance 1939."

AMENDMENT.

2. The Lismore Land Mortgage Ordinance 1934 is amended by the addition of the following words at the end of Section 1 thereof, that is to say :-

"and if and so often as the principal moneys obtained and raised by loan under the powers conferred by this ordinance shall have become repayable the said Bishop is hereby authorised and empowered in like manner in all respects to obtain and raise by loan a sum not exceeding the amount of such principal moneys or so much thereof as shall remain unpaid."

APPLICATION

- 3. The said Ordinance is further amended by the addition of the following subsection after subsection (a) of Section 2. that is to say :=
 - "(b) In repaying all principal monies already obtained and raised by loan under the powers conferred by this ordinance or so much thereof as shall remain unpaid."
