PORT MACQUARIE GLEBE (Amendment) ORDINANCE, 1949.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Port Macquarie Glebe Ordinance 1948 (hereinafter called "the Principal Ordinance") WHEREAS it has become expedient for the Trustees to delegate certain of their powers and functions in and about the carrying out of the Trusts prescribed by and under the Principal Ordinance And whereas by Act of Parliament passed in the eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George the Fifth entitled "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 No. 21," it was menacted that during the recess of the Synod, a Committee, Council, or other body of persons appointed for that purpose by Ordinance might, in place of the Synod of the Diocese exercise such of the powers and functions and do and make such of the things referred to in the said Act as should be determined by Ordinance of the Synod of such Diocese AND WHEREAS by Ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton passed in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty four the Bishopin-Council was appointed for the purpose of exercising and might accordingly during the recess of such Synod of the said Diocese exercise in the place of such Synod any or all of the powers and functions and do and make any or all of the things referred to in Sections 26 and 27 of the said Act as may be done by the Synod NOW THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Act and the said Ordinance and in pursuance of the powers yested in the said Synod by the Constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the Satet of New South Wales and by the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" or otherwise in the name and in the place of such Synod ordains, directs and rules as follows:-

SHORT TITLE

- (a) This Ordinance may be cited as the Port Macquarie Glebe (Amendment) Ordinance 1949.
 - (b) The Port Macquarie Glebe Ordinance 1948 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
 - (c) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the "Port Macquarie "Glebe Ordinance 1948-1949"
- The following Section shall be inserted and read immediately following Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance.
- The said Trustees may instead of acting peraonally employ and pay a Solicitor or other Agent to transact any business sign and execute any contract agreement or other document on their behalf or do any act required to be done in connection with the trusts hereby declared including the receipt and payment of money and shall be entitled to be allowed and paid all chaques and expenses so incurred and shall not be responsible for the default of any such Solicitor or Agent or any loss occasioned by his employment
