CLERGY STIPEND (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1952

AN ORDINANCE.

To amend the Clergy Stipend Ordinance 1947-1951 by increasing the travelling allowances of Clergy within the Diccese of Grafton WHEREAS by Section 18 subsection (h) of an Ordinance of the Synod of the Diccese of Grafton passed in the year One thousand nine hundred and thirty four and known as the Bishop-in-Council Ordinanco 1934 the Bishop-in-Council was thereby empowered to discharge all duties specifically assigned to it from time to time by the Synod of the Diccose under resolution consistently with the constitution of the Church and the Ordinances of Synod AND WHEREAS by a resolution duly submitted to and carried at a session of the said Synod upon the twenty-fourth day of September One thousand nine hundred and fifty two the Bishop-in-Council was thereby directed to increase the travelling allowances of Clergy within the Dicceso as hereinafter provided NOW THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council of the Synod of the Discose of Graft. n in pursuance of the powers and duties in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Ordinance and resolution and in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Syned by the constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of Now South Wales or otherwise in the name and in the place of such Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:-

SHORT TITLE:

- This Ordinance may be cited as the "Clorgy Stipend (Amendment) Ordinance (a)
- The Clergy Stipend Ordinance 1947 as amended by subsequent Ordinances and this Ordinance may be cited as the "Clergy Stipend (Amendment) Ordinance 1947-1952."
- Section 4 Subsection (a) of the Clergy Stipend (Amendment) Ordinance 1951 is hereby amended by substituting the word and figure "Eight pence (8d)" for the word and figure "Sixpence (6d)".

This Ordinance shall be retrospective to 1st October, 1952.
