

### QUORUM.

8. Five members of the Committee shall form a quorum.

### MEETINGS.

9. The Committee shall meet not less than four times in each year at such times and places as the Bishop shall appoint.

### FUND.

10. There shall be a fund to be known as the Grafton Diocesan Youth Committee Fund and into the fund shall be paid all monies collected or received for the purpose.

### FUNCTIONS.

11. The duties and functions of the Committee shall be:—

- (a) To co-ordinate the activities of all Youth Groups in the Diocese.
- (b) To collect a Diocesan Capitation fee from every Youth Organisation for each of its members which will be in addition to the usual affiliation fee.
- (c) To recommend purchase of equipment for Youth activities and to acquire and control same.
- (d) To administer, subject to the approval of the Corporate Trustees or the Bishop-in-Council as the case may be, all monies both capital and current that may belong or hereafter shall be contributed to the Grafton Diocesan Youth Committee Fund.
- (e) To arrange with the approval of the Bishop-in-Council for all appeals on behalf of the Diocesan Youth Committee Fund or in connection with any other Youth Organisations within the Diocese.
- (f) To arrange for the carrying out of any other business connected with Diocesan Youth matters submitted by the Bishop.

### BY-LAWS.

12. The Committee may make by-laws for the carrying out of the several duties assigned to it under this Ordinance.

### REPORT.

13. The Committee shall after the close of each financial year submit a report of its operations together with a statement of accounts and audited balance sheet to the Bishop-in-Council for presentation to Synod.

## The Diocesan Education Ordinance, 1933. Amendment Ordinance, 1948.

### AN ORDINANCE.

To amend the Diocesan Education Ordinance 1933 by increasing the representation upon the Diocesan Board of Education.

The Bishop, the Clergy and the Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled declare ordain and enact as follows:—

### SHORT TITLE.

1. This ordinance may be cited as "The Diocesan Education Ordinance 1933 Amendment Ordinance 1948."

### AMENDMENT.

2. Section 2 of the Diocesan Education Ordinance 1933 is hereby amended by inserting between the words "The Archdeacons" and "The Minister of a Parish" where therein appearing, the following words namely:—

The Vice-Chairman of the Youth Committee.

The Youth Commissioner.

The Church Mail Bag School Secretary.

## SHORT TIT

  - 13A. In addition to the appointments as hereinbefore provided the Bishop shall have and may exercise the right to confer the title Canon Emeritus upon the Reverend J. W. V. Synonds.
