

PORT MACQUARIE LAND MORTGAGE (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1959

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Port Macquarie Land Mortgage Ordinance 1959 (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Ordinance") by substituting a new parcel of lands for that comprised in the Principal Ordinance AND WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 it was enacted that during the recess of the Synod a Committee Council or other body of persons appointed for that purpose by Ordinance might in place of the Synod of the Diocese exercise such of the powers and functions and do and make such of the things referred to in the said Act as should be determined by Ordinance of the Synod of such Diocese AND WHEREAS by an Ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton passed in the year One thousand nine hundred and thirty four the Bishop-in-Council was appointed for the purpose of exercising and might accordingly during the recess of such Synod of the said Diocese exercise in the place of such Synod any or all of the powers and functions and do and make any or all of the things referred to in Section 26 of the said Act as may be done by the Synod AND WHEREAS such Synod is now in recess NOW THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Act and Ordinance and of the powers vested in the said Synod by the Constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917 or otherwise in the name and in the place of such Synod ordains, directs and rules as follows:-

SHORT TITLE

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Port Macquarie Land Mortgage (Amendment) Ordinance 1959."

AMENDMENT

2. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted:-


THE SCHEDULE.

ALL THOSE 1 acre 29 perches or thereabouts part of Section 7 having a frontage of 312 feet 2 inches to Murray Street by a depth of 165 feet situate in the Town of Port Macquarie Parish and County of Macquarie and being the Eastern moiety of the lands comprised in Crown Grant dated 25th March, 1875 registered Volume 247 Folio 116.
