

THE CASINO LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1965 (AMENDING ORDINANCE) 1966

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Casino Land Sale Ordinance 1965 to permit of a variation of Trust.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the property described in the schedule hereto is vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act of 1917 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance of 1934 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during a recess of Synod to exercise certain powers of such recess now exists the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod ordains directs and rules as follows:

OPINION

1. It is inexpedient to carry out the Trust created by the Casino Land Sale Ordinance 1965

REPEAL

2. Clause 4 of the Casino Land Sale Ordinance is herewith repealed.

APPLICATION OF TRUST MONEY

3. Monies comprised in the schedule hereto shall be applied to the purchase of an organ for the Parish Church of St. Mark, Casino.

SHORT TITLE

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Casino Land Sale Ordinance 1965 (Amending Ordinance 1966)

SCHEDULE

The sum of \$877.69 being proceeds of the sale of land under the Casino Land Sale Ordinance 1965.
