

CLERGY STIPEND (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1958

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Clergy Stipend (Amendment) Ordinance 1951 in connection with the Stipends and Allowances of Clergy within the Diocese of Grafton.

The Bishop, the Clergy and the Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled declare, ordain, and enact as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Clergy Stipend (Amendment) Ordinance 1958."

AMENDMENT

2. Section 2 of the Clergy Stipend (Amendment) Ordinance 1951 is repealed and the following Section substituted:

MINIMUM STIPENDS

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Parochial Ordinance 1936, the Status of Parishes Regulation Ordinance 1933, or any other Ordinance, Stipends and Allowances payable to Clergy shall henceforth be at rates per annum not less than:

For Rector, £850.0.0. with residence and £50.0.0. allowance for hospitality and expenses of office.

For Vicar, £740.0.0. with residence and £50.0.0. allowance for hospitality and expenses of office.

For Priest, £710.0.0. and, should he be in residence, such hospitality allowance as shall be fair and reasonable, and determined by the Parochial Council.

For Deacon (2nd year), £650.0.0; and,
For Deacon (1st year), £620.0.0.

Such stipends to be subject to the rise and fall of the basic wage.
