PROPERTY ALLOCATION ORDINANCE, 1913.

THE DIOCESAN PROPERTY ALLOCATION ORDINANCE,
1913.

Whereas the Committee appointed in pursuance of the Grafton Diocesan Ordinance, 1910, has determined that the money, funds and property set out in the Schedule hereto shall be allocated between the areas to be respectively constituted the Diocese of Grafton and the Diocese of Armidale as provided in such Schedule. And whereas it is expedient that such determination shall be accepted by Synod. . . And whereas the Bishop of Grafton and Armidale has approved in writing of the formation of a Diocese of Grafton.

Be it therefore enacted ordained and declared by the Bishop Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton and Armidale in synod assembled as follows:—

1. The determination of the Committee appointed in pursuance of the Grafton Diocese Ordinance 1910 set out in the Schedule hereto as to the allocation of the money funds and property referred to in such determination is hereby accepted and confirmed.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Diocesan Allocation Ordinance, 1913."

SCHEDULE.

(A) CLERGY PROVIDENT FUND CAPITAL AND CURRENT ACCOUNTS.

CHURCH MANAGEMENT FUND.

DIOCESAN BOOK DEPOT FUND.

DIOCESAN BUILDINGS REPAIRS FUND.

AND all property that may be given to any of the said Funds by any instrument bearing date prior to the installation of the Bishop of Grafton in the proportion of Six (6) parts to Grafton and Seven (7) parts to Armidale.

(B) CHURCH EXTENSION FUND CAPITAL AND CURRENT ACCOUNTS.

CHURCH AND DIOCESAN PURPOSES GENERALLY

AND all property that may be given to any of the said

Funds by any instrument bearing date prior to the installation of the Bishop of Grafton in the proportion of Two (2) parts to Grafton and Three (3) parts to Armidale.

(C) That the Grafton Diocese be entitled to send students to St. John's College at the lowest rate chargeable to Armidale students, and that St. John's Theological College Real and Personal Estate and Capital Funds shall remain the property of the Armidale Diocese and that in the event of the College ceasing to be carried on for the purposes for which it is at present carried on and the property is sold, the proceeds of the sale of such land and buildings less the amount expended in the meantime and until such sale aforesaid on additions and repairs together with the amount standing to the credit of the Capital Fund as at the date of the Installation of the Bishop of Grafton shall be divided in the proportion of Two parts to Grafton and Three parts to Armidale.

(D) ALL the rest and residue of the real and personal property now outside the Territory to be constituted the Diocese of Grafton shall be vested in Trustees for the Diocese of Armidale.
