

Delegation of Powers.

DELEGATION OF POWERS ORDINANCE, 1918.

1918 No. 1.

WHEREAS by the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917 it is provided that during the recess of the Synod a Diocese such Committee Council or other body of persons (if any) as shall from time to time be constituted or appointed for the purpose by or under Ordinance of the Synod of such Diocese may in place of the Synod of such Diocese exercise such of the powers and functions and do and make such the things referred to in the said Act as shall from time to time be determined by the Synod of such Diocese; and WHEREAS it is desirable that provision be made by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton for the exercise and performance of such powers and functions during the recess of the said Synod: Be it therefore ordained of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton under and by the virtue of the powers conferred on it by the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917, as follows:—

1. The Council of the Diocese of Grafton is hereby appointed to exercise during the recess of Synod such of the powers and functions as are conferred on the Synod of the Diocese and to do and perform such of the things required of the said Synod by Sections 12, 13, 14, 15, 19, 24, 25, 27, 28, 31, 32, 37, and 39 of the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917.

2. The said Council is hereby empowered to make regulations and regulations from time to time for the sale, leasing, mortgaging of lands vested in the Corporate Trust of the Diocese.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1918."
