

Diocese of Grafton.

PORT MACQUARIE LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1922.

WHEREAS the lands more particularly described in the Schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton LAND WHEREAS it is expedient to sell the same and apply the proceeds as hereinafter directed: BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 as follows:—

1. THE CORPORATE TRUSTEES in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the said lands either by public auction or private contract on such terms as they shall think fit with full power to execute the necessary transfers and assurances for transferring and conveying the said lands to the purchasers thereof.
2. NO PURCHASERS of the said lands under the powers hereby conferred shall be bound or concerned to enquire whether such power shall have been duly and properly exercised in accordance with the next preceding section or be affected by any notice to the contrary.
3. THE MONEYS arising out of such sale shall be applied in the first place to defray costs of same and the balance shall be expended towards repairs on Vicarage and Sunday School.
4. THIS ORDINANCE may be cited as the 'Port Macquarie Land Sale Ordinance 1922.'

THE SCHEDULE.

ALL THAT piece of land situated in the Parish of Port Macquarie County of Macquarie containing twenty-seven and one-half perches being the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title dated the thirty-first day of December 1866 registered volume 36 folio 151 and being part of allotment two of section five of the Town of Port Macquarie.
