

**GRAFTON LAND MORTGAGE AMENDMENT
ORDINANCE, 1929**

PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS by the Grafton Land Mortgage Ordinance, 1928, provision is made for limiting the sum of money to be raised by mortgage and whereas it has become expedient to vary the provisions contained in section one of the said Ordinance and it is in the opinion of the Council of the Diocese of Grafton desirable to amend the same he it therefore ordained by the Council of the Diocese of Grafton in exercise of the powers granted and conferred by Section 32 of the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917, and by the Delegation of Powers Ordinance, 1918, as follows:—

AMENDMENT.

(1) Section one of the Grafton Land Mortgage Ordinance, 1928, is hereby amended by deleting the word "two," at the end of line three and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "three," and further after the word "thousand" in line four delete the word "one," and insert in lieu thereof the word "two."

SHORT TITLE.

(2) This Ordinance may be cited as the "Grafton Land Mortgage Amendment Ordinance, 1929."
