

AUSTRALIAN CHURCH CONSTITUTION CONSENTING
ORDINANCE 1927, REPEAL ORDINANCE 1933

PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS by reason of change of circumstances the Ordinance named in the schedule hereto is not now required; BE IT THEREFORE enacted by the Bishop, Clergy and Laity in Synod assembled as follows:—

REPEAL.

1. The Ordinance named in the Schedule hereto is hereby repealed except as to any operation already effected by or act done under any enactment therein comprised or as to any right title, obligation or liability already acquired or accrued under any such enactment.
