**DETERMINATIONS AND ORDINANCES ACCEPTANCE
ORDINANCE, 1914.**

1914. No. 10.

Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient to lay down the mode of accepting determinations of the General Synod of the Dioceses in Australia and Tasmania and Ordinances of the Provincial Synod of New South Wales by the Church in the Diocese of Grafton: Be it ordained by the Synod of the said Diocese as follows, that is to say:—

Method of Acceptance.

1. From and after the passing of this Ordinance, the mode of accepting any determination of the General Synod of the Dioceses in Australia and Tasmania, or any Ordinance of the Provincial Synod of New South Wales by the Church in the Diocese of Grafton shall be by Resolution of the Synod of the Diocese.

Effect of Resolution of Acceptance.

2. Every Resolution accepting any Determination or Ordinance as aforesaid shall have the force of an Ordinance passed by the Synod.

Short Title.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Determinations and Ordinances Acceptance Ordinance 1914."
