

or private contract for such price in such parcels on such terms and conditions as they shall think fit and also to execute all deeds or other instruments and do all acts measures and things necessary for carrying into effect the said sale.

2. The moneys arising from any such sale shall after payment thereof of all proper costs charges and expenses be applied for and towards the erection of a Vicarage or dwelling house for the Vicar of Kempsey.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Kempsey Land Sale Ordinance 1918."

**The Schedule.**

All that piece of land situated in the Town of West Kempsey Parish of Kalateene County of Dudley containing Two roads being Allotment 8 Section 38 being the whole of the lands comprised in Crown Grant dated 3rd December 1879 registered volume 482 Folio 75 Also all that piece of land situated in the Town Parish and County aforesaid containing One acre being Allotment 10 Section 38 being the whole of the lands comprised in Crown Grant dated 3rd December 1879 registered volume 482 Folio 76 And also all that piece of land situated in the Town Parish and County aforesaid being Allotment 9 Section 38 Commencing on the right bank of the Macleay River at the North-Eastern corner of Allotment 10 and bounded thence on the West by the Eastern boundary of that Allotment bearing South 8 chains 30 links to Bloomfield Street On the South by that Street bearing East 61 links On the East by the Western boundary of Allotment 8 bearing North 8 chains 40 links to the right bank of the aforesaid river and On the North by that Bank upwards to the point of commencement.

**KEMPSEY LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1918.**

WHEREAS the lands more particularly described in the Schedule hereunder written and situated in the Town of West Kempsey Parish of Kalateene County of Dudley are now vested in certain Trustees and are held for Church purposes AND WHEREAS it is intended that the same shall become vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts of the said lands it appears to the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton to be expedient to sell the said lands and to apply the proceeds as hereinafter directed BE it therefore enacted ordained and declared by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 as follows

1. So soon as the said lands shall have become vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton the said Trustees are directed to sell the same either by public auction
