Casino Church of England Grammar School Ordinance

1917 No. 2.

PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS the Parochial Council of Casino has, with the approval of the Bishop of Grafton, established a School at Casino for the purpose of imparting to children a sound and liberal education, and of training such children in the Faith of the Church of England; AND WHEREAS the said School since its establishment has been under the management of a Board consisting of the Bishop, the Vicar of Casino and one layman appointed by the Parochial Council; AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the Diocese should take cognisance of all educational institutions established within the Diocese for the purpose aforesaid, and should frame rules and regulations touching the constitution, election, and powers of the Board of Management of the said school and the course of instruction to be imparted therein, and all matters in connection with the good order and discipline thereof: NOW, therefore, the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales, ordains and declares as follows:—

NAME OF SCHOOL.

1. The name of the School shall be Casino Church of England Grammar School.

OBJECT.

2. The object of the School shall be to impart a sound and liberal education to children, including regular religious instruction in conformity with the principles of the Church of England.

BOARD OF MANAGEMENT.

3. The Board of Management—hereinafter called "the Board"—shall consist of the Bishop of Grafton, as President, the Archdeacon of the Richmond and Tweed (ex-officio), the Vicar of Casino, as Vice President, and one layman, who may act as Secretary of the Board and School Treasurer, and who shall be elected by the Annual Meeting of Parishioners at Casino.

3a. In the event of the elected layman being unable to act as Secretary of the Board and School Treasurer it shall be within the power of the Board to appoint a suitable person to fill this position who shall not be thereby a member of the Board.

ABSENCE OF BISHOP.

4. In the absence of the Bishop or during the vacancy of the See, the Administrator shall be summoned to meetings of the Board as ex-officio Representative of the Bishop.

MEETINGS OF BOARD.

5. The Secretary shall summon meetings of the Board when so required by the Bishop or the Vicar of Casino and at such meetings two shall form a quorum.

APPOINTMENT OF TEACHERS.

6. The Board shall have the right of all appointments of Masters and Mistresses of the School.

COURSE OF INSTRUCTION.

7. Subject to the ultimate control of Synod, it shall be competent for the Board to determine the curriculum of instruction in religious and secular subjects, and all matters in connection with the order and discipline of the School.

PROPERTY, ETC.

8. The Board shall manage the property and finance of the School, as may appear expedient to it for the benefit of the School, and the Board shall be responsible for all liabilities.

REPORT TO SYNOD.

9. The progress and condition of the School shall be the subject of an Annual Report to Synod, and at the same time a balance sheet duly audited shall be presented.

SHORT TITLE.

10. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Casino Church of England Grammar School Ordinance, 1917."
