

### DIOCESAN REGISTRY EXCHANGE ORDINANCE, 1921.

Ordinance Passed by Third Synod, Special Session, May, 1921.

WHEREAS it is desirable that the land described in the First Schedule hereto, which is now held as Parochial land in trust for Parsonage purposes in the Parish of Grafton should become Diocesan lands and should be made available for the erection of a Diocesan Registry, and that the land described in the Second Schedule hereto should become Parochial land and be held as an addition to the yard or curtilage of the Parish Hall in the Parish of Grafton. Be it therefore ordained by the Synod of Grafton as follows:—

1. The land described in the First Schedule is hereby exchanged for the land described in the Second Schedule hereto.
2. The land described in the First Schedule shall henceforth be held as Diocesan land in trust for the purposes of a Diocesan Registry.
3. The land described in the Second Schedule hereto shall henceforth be held as Parochial land as an addition to the yard and curtilage of the Parish Hall at Grafton.
4. The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton are hereby authorised to make do and execute all such acts, deeds, assurances and things as may be found necessary for carrying out the provisions of this Ordinance.
5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Diocesan Registry Exchange Ordinance, 1921.

### THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL THAT piece of land situated in the County of Clarence, Parish of Great Marlow and Town of Grafton being part of Allotment No. 7 of Section No. 5 COMMENCING at a point in the South-western side of Victoria street, at the Eastermost corner of Allotment No. 7 aforesaid and bounded thence on the North-east by part of the South-western side of Victoria street North-westerly thirty feet Thence on the North-west by a line at right angles to Victoria street bearing South-westerly ninety feet Thence by a line parallel to Victoria street bearing South-easterly

thirty feet to the South-eastern boundary of Allotment No. 7 aforesaid and thence on the South-east by part of the last-mentioned boundary being a line bearing North-easterly ninety feet to the point of commencement.

#### THE SECOND SCHEDULE.

ALL THAT piece of land situated in the County of Clarence Parish of Great Marlow and Town of Grafton COMMENCING at a point in the South-western side of Fitzroy street, being the Easternmost corner of the present yard of curtilage of the Grafton Parish Hall and bounded thence on the North-east by the South-western side of Fitzroy street aforesaid South-easterly 18 feet to the Easternmost corner of Allotment 7 aforesaid being the Northernmost corner of Allotment 6 and bounded thence on the South-east by part of the North-western boundary of Allotment 6 aforesaid South-easterly 165 feet Thence on the South-west by a line parallel to Fitzroy street bearing North-westerly 18 feet to the present yard or curtilage of the Grafton Parish Hall and thence on the North-west by the South-eastern boundary of that yard or curtilage or curtilage of the Grafton Parish Hall and thence on the North-west by the South-eastern boundary of that yard or curtilage North-westerly 165 feet to the point of commencement. ALSO ALL THAT piece of land situated in the County of Clarence Parish of Great Marlow Town of Grafton being part of original Allotment No. 6 of Section 9 aforesaid COMMENCING at a point in the South-western side of Fitzroy street being the Easternmost corner of Allotment No. 7 aforesaid and bounded thence on the North-east by the Southern side of Fitzroy street along said South-easterly 15 feet Thence on the South-east by a line at right angles to Fitzroy street bearing South-westerly 165 feet Thence on the South-west by a line parallel to Fitzroy street bearing North-westerly 15 feet to the South-eastern boundary of Allotment No. 7 aforesaid and thence on the North-west by part of the South-eastern boundary of Allotment No. 7 aforesaid North Easterly 165 feet to the point of commencement.

#### DIOCESAN COUNCIL AMENDMENT ORDINANCE, 1921. PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend further the Diocesan Council Ordinance, 1914: Be it therefore ordained by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton as follows:—

#### AMENDMENT—CONSTITUTION.

1. Section 2 of the said Ordinance is amended by the deletion of all the words after the word "President" in the third line, and further by the addition after the said word "President" of the words "The Administrator of the Diocese, and the Chairman of Committees, and thirty other members to be determined as hereinafter provided."

#### AMENDMENT—ELECTIVE MEMBERS.

2. Section 3 of the said Ordinance is amended by the deletion of the words "three clergymen and three laymen" in line 3, and further by the insertion in lieu thereof of the words "five clergymen and five laymen."
