

DESIGNATION OF MINISTERS AMENDMENT
ORDINANCE, 1928

PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend certain Ordinances to provide for the alteration of the designation of a Minister in charge of a Parish or Parochial District. BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton as follows:—

AMENDMENT.

(1) When and wheresoever reference is made to a Minister instituted to the Cure of Souls in a Parish he shall be styled Rector, and the residence of such Minister shall be styled Rectory.

(2) When and wheresoever reference is made to a Minister duly licensed to the Cure of Souls in a Parochial District he shall be styled Vicar, and the residence of such Minister shall be styled a Vicarage.

(3) All ordinances in force in the Diocese of Grafton affected by this ordinance shall be deemed to be amended accordingly.

SHORT TITLE.

(4) This Ordinance may be cited as "The Designation of Ministers Amendment Ordinance, 1928."
