

THE CONSTITUTIONS AMENDING PROMOTING
ORDINANCE, 1930

PREAMBLE.

AN ORDINANCE to promote an Act of Parliament to amend the Church of England Constitutions Act Amendment Act, of 1902, and for other purposes. The Synod of the Diocese of Grafton hereby ordains and rules as follows:—

(1) The Diocesan Council is hereby directed and authorised to take all necessary steps to promote an Act of Parliament to amend the Church of England Constitutions Act Amendment Act, of 1902, by inserting at the end of clause twenty-one of the Constitutions for the Management and Good Government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales, set out in the Schedule to the said Act words to the following effect, namely:—

“In the case of mental incapacity opportunity to show cause may be given by such procedure whether with or without personal service of any process as the Synod may prescribe by Ordinance.”

(2) This Ordinance may be cited as “The Constitutions Amending Promoting Ordinance, 1930.”
