

TRUSTEES OF GRAFTON AUTHORISATION ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORISING PAYMENT AND TRANSFER OF MONEYS AND INVESTMENTS TO TRUSTEES PROVIDED FOR UNDER THE DIOCESE OF GRAFTON ORDINANCE, 1913.

Whereas by virtue of 'The Diocese of Grafton Ordinance 1913' a new Diocese called the Diocese of Grafton has been duly formed. And in pursuance of clause seven thereof the Diocese of Grafton and Armidale was to be called the Diocese of Armidale from and after the installation of a person as Bishop of the Diocese of Grafton. And in pursuance of clause twelve thereof certain moneys and investments were the subject of an allocation. And in pursuance of clause thirteen thereof on the installation and on the determination of such allocation the portions allocated were to be paid transferred or assigned to Trustees to be provided for the same by an Ordinance of the Synod of the said Diocese of Grafton. And Whereas by virtue of the Diocesan Allocation Ordinance 1913 the said allocation was determined as thereby appearing. And Whereas on the twenty-sixth day of March one thousand nine hundred and fourteen the Right Reverend Cecil Henry Druitt was duly installed as Bishop of Grafton. And Whereas under the provisions of the Church of England Trust Property Incorporation Act 1881 Laurence Edwin Cope, Clarence John Ledger, Charles Alfred Gordon Lillingston, Herbert Arthur Evans, and William Barrett King were elected the Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton and by a notification in the 'Government Gazette' on the 8th day of July 1914 the said Trustees were gazetted as the Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton under the name of The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton; the Synod of the Diocese of Armidale assembled in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales, ordains and rules as follows:—

1. That the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton be the Trustees provided by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton and the moneys and investments in the portions allocated to the said Diocese under the Diocesan Property Allocation Ordinance 1913 be paid transferred or assigned to the said Trustees.
2. This Ordinance may be cited as 'The Corporate Trustees of Grafton Authorisation Ordinance 1914.'
