

MACLEAN VICARAGE MORTGAGE ORDINANCE, 1914.

Whereas by Crown Grant, dated the 31st day of May, 1876, the land more particularly described in the Schedule to this Ordinance was granted and conveyed to the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton and Armidale; And whereas the said land is now included within the Diocese of Grafton, and it is intended that it shall become vested in the Corporate Trustees for that Diocese so soon as such Trustees have been duly constituted; And whereas the said land is held as a site for the Vicarage of the Parish of Maclean; And whereas in the opinion of the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton it has become expedient to erect a new Vicarage thereon and to carry out other work in connection therewith and for such purposes to obtain an advance of money not exceeding five hundred pounds on the security of the said land: Be it therefore ordained and declared by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton, with the consent of the incumbent and a majority of the Churchwardens and Parochial Council of the said Parish of Maclean and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Church of England Property Act of 1889, as follows:—

1. The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton are hereby authorised and empowered to mortgage the lands described in the Schedule to this Ordinance for the purpose of obtaining an advance on the security thereof of such sum not exceeding five hundred pounds as the Parochial Council of the Parish of Maclean shall require and as the said Trustees shall deem necessary, so soon as the said lands shall have become vested in them.

2. The principal moneys to be raised by such mortgage shall be applied for and towards the erection of a new Vicarage at Maclean aforesaid, and the removal or disposition of the old Vicarage and work in connection therewith.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the 'Maclean Vicarage Mortgage Ordinance, 1914.'

SCHEDULE.

All that allotment or parcel of land contained by admeasurement 2 rods be the same more or less situated in the County of Clarence, Parish of Taloumbi, and Town of Maclean, being Allotment 4 of Section 11. Commencing on the Southern side of Wharf-street at the North-Eastern corner of J. McDonald's allotment three and bounded thence on the North by that street Easterly two chains on the East by the Western boundary line of allotment five, southerly at right angles to Wharf-street two chains and fifty links to a lane on the South, by that lane Westerly parallel with Wharf-street two chains, and on the West by the Eastern boundary line of allotment three aforesaid, North-erly at right angles to Wharf-street two chains and fifty links to the point of commencement.
